**CAPITAL FUND DRIVE:** The school roof is now 29 years old and needs to be replaced. Sentry Roofing gave a bid of \$258,940 that included the gym roof, the lower school roof, and added insulation. The fundraising will take a couple of years to get the dollars needed. This project will not be scheduled until all of the money is in the Capital Fund account. There is a display in the narthex; please stop by and look at it. The display shows the deterioration of the roof surfaces and a fundraising thermometer which will show our progress towards the goal of \$260,000.
